

How to make a 'Dream catcher' – Bishop Alexander style

Materials

Two pieces of card (preferably coloured)

Glue

Scissors (use with a responsible adult)

Tissue paper (coloured)

String

Two circular objects, one large and one medium (to use as a stencil)

Colouring crayons/ felt tips

Instructions

Firstly, gather your resources (see above).

Secondly, stick two pieces of coloured card together with glue.

Then, draw round the larger circle, then get your smaller circle and draw round this so that you now have two circles like this...



After that, cut out the outer circle and then the middle circle, so you are left with a doughnut shape.



Now, cut string in to 20cm lengths and wrap it inside and out of your circle (which should look like a mesh pattern).



In addition, use tissue paper, colours/ felt tips and other household items to decorate the 'ring'.

Finally, cut a 15cm length of string, and attach it to the top (in a loop), so you can hang your dream catcher!
