Digimap for Schools <https://digimapforschools.edina.ac.uk/login>

Digimap is an online mapping tool which allows the user to explore a range of current and historical maps and aerial photography, all of which can be annotated, searched, measured and personalised. It includes Ordnance Survey maps, historical maps of the 1890s and 1950s, aerial photography from Getmapping and Collins Bartholomew World Panorama world reference map (information from Open Street Map augments the global illustration).

### KS1

Can you find your house on the map? See if you can complete a scavenger hunt in your house or on a walk. Take some photos and you can add these to your map. This video will explain how.
