

Salt Dough Decorations

You will need

- 2 cups of flour
- 1 cup of salt
- 1 cup of cold water



Instructions

1. Mix the flour and salt together in a bowl
2. Slowly mix in the water a little at a time until a dough is formed. If it's too dry add little more water, if it's too sticky add a little more flour.
3. Knead the dough for a few minutes until the dough is smooth.
4. Now it's time to create your decorations. You can roll out the dough using a rolling pin and cut out shapes using any biscuit or play dough cutters. Or get creative and make your own shapes using the dough. Why not have a go at making a rainbow for your window or the letters in your name?
5. If you want to hang your decorations then don't forget to make a small hole in your using a pencil.
6. Put your decorations in a baking tray and ask an adult to help you put them in the oven at 120°C (or as low as your oven will go) for 2 hours until they are hard and dry.
7. Once they are cooled you can decorate them with paint or felt tips.
8. Finally thread some string or ribbon through the holes on your decorations and they are ready to be hung up.
