You are going to become an Artist!

1. Who is your favourite artist and artwork by them? What is it that inspires you to be creative or WOW'S you? What character would you most like to learn how to draw?

You are going to write instructions about how to create a piece of ART, by your chosen artist. Great artists/styles over the decades include Banksy, Van Gogh, Mondrian, Picasso, Andy Warhol and many more!

2. Next, use a child friendly search engine eg 'Kiddle' to research artists and characters from your chosen genre and look at their work.

3. Below is a link to the Disney how to draw series, practise drawing 2/3 of the famous Disney characters and you could even choose one of your favourites to complete, when you write your instructions.

4. Choose your favourite (see if you can draw one without instructions!) and begin to research how to draw the artwork.

5. Take notes, in detail (DON'T copy from the internet, put your notes into bullet points and your own words) and start to gather key information that will help you write your instructions.

Things to consider including in your instructions: - artist and artwork/ character – list of equipment needed – techniques needed and any tips or tricks.

Then, draft a first version of your instructions – aim to make it as detailed, neat and well presented as you can! Keep your standards high! Once you have completed your first draft, use time to edit and improve your writing – think about word choices, conjunctions, modal verbs, punctuation use and grammar. Remember to also draw the outcome of your instructions so you can show the finished piece as a WAGOLL!

A Year 5 should be able to write a page of A4 at least and a Year 6 should aim for even more! Take your time and make it your very best work! Send pictures (not the text itself) of your completed biographies to sallyh28@bishopalexanderacademy.co.uk so we can see them and post some on Twitter.
