Red cars – 2 Blue cars – 5</p>	<p>Draw your favourite character from the story 'The Gingerbread Man' and try writing the name of it. E.g., cow.</p>	<p>Practise reading your first and last name?</p>	<p>Create your own shadow puppet show using a torch.</p>	<p>Talk about different people who keep us safe. E.g. Lollypop person crossing the road, Nurses when we feel poorly. Draw some different people who keep you safe.</p>
<p>Time yourself. How long does it take you to get dressed or tidy your toys away?</p>	<p>How many different letters can you spot when you are out shopping?</p>	<p>What fruits and vegetables do you have in your house? What sounds do they start with? E.g. 'c' for 'carrot'.</p>	<p>Using recycled materials could you make a model of a computer or a radio?</p>	<p>Design your own healthy plate. Can you label what different foods you have chosen?</p>
<p>Write the numbers 1 to 10 using different tools (crayons, paintbrush or in the sand).</p>	<p>Can you hold a pencil or pen using the pincer grip?</p>	<p>Pick your favourite book. What letters can you find inside it?</p>	<p>Draw some foods that you might have at a special occasion. E.g. birthday, Christmas etc.</p>	<p>Make a fruit kebab using 4/5 different fruits.</p>
<p>Go on a shape hunt. What different shapes can you find? E.g. round window</p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favourite book character?</p>	<p>Sing a nursery rhyme and perform the actions too.</p>	<p>With an adult, talk about the safe use of electrical devices in your home.</p>	<p>Pick three of your favourite fruits and vegetables. Can you draw and describe them?</p>
