Go on a bug hunt. Count how many different mini-beasts you can find in your garden.	Read 5 times a week and write it in your diary.	Can you read the high frequency words in your diary? How many can you read in one minute?	Draw some foods that you might have at a special occasion. E.g. birthday, Christmas etc.	Pick three of your favourite fruits and vegetables. Can you position them and draw a picture?
Write your numbers to 10 and order them. Take a photo.	Write a recipe for your favourite meal.	Practise your set one sounds. How many can you recognise?	Shine a torch at the wall and create your own shadow puppet show for your family to watch.	Create your own musical instrument using recycled materials. E.g. a rainmaker using a yoghurt pot and rice.
Create your own survey, Count how many different coloured cars you see on your walk to school. E.g. Red cars – 2 Blue cars – 5	Let an adult read a story to you. Can you answer some questions about the story? E.g. What was the character's name?	Practise forming your letters. How many can you write independently?	Go on a hunt and see how many electrical devices you have in your home. Create your own tally chart for your findings. E.g. iPad – III -3 TV – II - 2 Mobiles – IIII - 4	Design your own healthy plate. Can you label what different foods you have chosen?
Time yourself. How long does it take you to get dressed or eat your breakfast?	Look at the I Spy sheet, what different pictures can you see and write down?	Pick your favourite book. What high frequency words can you find inside it?	Take a look at Nina and the Neurons on CBeebies. What different scientific facts can you find out?	Talk about different people who keep us safe. E.g. Lollypop person crossing the road, Nurses when we feel poorly. Draw some different people who keep you safe.
Go on a shape hunt. What different shapes can you find? E.g. square window	Practise writing your name. How many times can you write it in one minute?	Pick a picture from the I Spy sheet. Can you hear what sounds that picture begins with? E.g. 'dog' 'd'	Make a mini computer using recycled materials. Include a screen and keys.	Find a recipe for some fruit/vegetable muffins. Can you make some with your adult?
